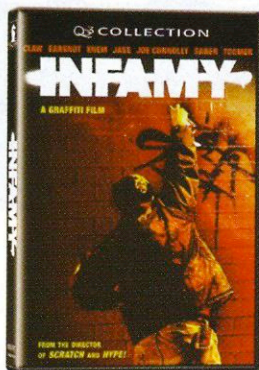

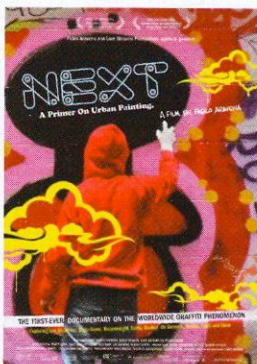


**Infamy**

Directed by the widely praised filmmaker behind the documentaries *Hype!* and *Scratch*, Doug Pray's *Infamy* takes you on a 90-minute spree of tags, throwups, pieces, testimonials, trains, and murals. Travel to North Philadelphia, the South Bronx, San Francisco's Tenderloin district, Cleveland's train yards, Mexico, and East Los Angeles for humor, self-assessment, irreverence, and vandalism. See late-night activity, witness the best of Graffiti Nation (CLAW, EARSNOT, ENEM, JASE, SABER, and TOOMER), and hear other interviews from MISS 17, REVOK, GKAE, journalist Sacha Jenkins, family members, and LA's notorious citizen buffer, Joe "The Graffiti Guerilla" Connolly. A little more than 90 minutes, *Infamy* also includes over 35 minutes of bonus features, such as details concerning the death of SABER'S close friend, TIE. Without moralizing or interpretation, *Infamy* gives you the real deal, straight up. —CC

Profiling the urban art and artists of nine countries, Pablo Aravena's film, *Next: A Primer on Urban Painting*, captures the soul of the street through a lucid verité style. You'll hear from painters, graffiti writers, designers, collectors, and others pulled from the sidewalk. The film begins and ends in New York City, and also travels to Montreal, Paris, Barcelona, Berlin, London, Amsterdam, Tokyo, Os aka, and São Paulo. Established and emerging artists include MODE 2, SKWERM, OTHER, JONONE, BBC, LOCUS, SHOE, THE CHROME ANGELS, SPACE INVADER, FAFI, ALEX ONE, ANDRE, BANDO, PSY, ONG CREW, AKIM, SHE-ONE, CHU, PIPS:LAB, REMCO, ZYS, CHLOE, ZEN ONE, SASU, KAMI, BOLETA, ONESTO, NUNCA, CIRO, BIRONE, RUI AMARAL, OS GEMEOS, VITCHE, NINA, HERBERT, EASE, and ROSTARR. Running just over 90 minutes, *Next* emphasizes the explosion of this important cultural phenomenon. In the words of SWOON, "If you just take the right, the right is yours." —CC
